APPROVING AMENDED DELAWARE NATION CITIZENSHIP ORDINANCE

- **WHEREAS**, the Delaware Nation is a federally-recognized Indian Tribe that operates in accordance with its Constitution, as ratified on April 21, 1973, as amended from time to time, and recognized by the Secretary of Interior; and
- WHEREAS, according to Article VI Powers of the Constitution, "the Executive Committee shall have specific authority...to promulgate and enforce ordinances and codes governing law and order to protect the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of Delaware tribal citizens...", and generally "shall have full authority to act on behalf of the Nation in all other matters upon which the Nation is empowered to act..."; and
- WHEREAS, the Delaware Nation Citizenship Ordinance, was passed by the Executive Committee with Resolution #2019-064 on May 14, 2019 by a vote of 6-0-0.
- WHEREAS, there is a need to amend Section 6: Application for Enrollment: Submission to Enrollment Director; Preliminary Processing: D(6) and D(7), E(3)Proof of Enrollment Eligibility for Adopted Person, Section 7-Processing of Applications: Time Limitations A(5) and Section 13-Records: A(3).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Delaware Nation Executive Committee has approved the Amended Delaware Nation Citizenship Ordinance with amendments.
